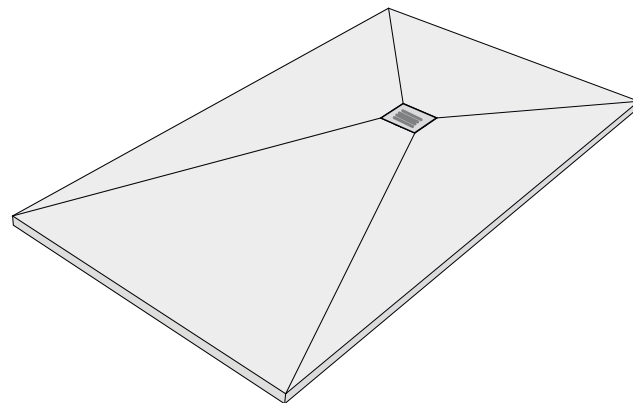


Cleaning Manual Shower Base



POST INSTALLATION

Use a descaler for expansion joints or a cement remover to eliminate any remaining cement, glue, or mortar residue.

To prevent scratching, avoid rubbing directly on the surface.

ROUTINE CLEANING

Use water, liquid cleaners and soft cloths or non-abrasive sponges. Do not use scourers as they can damage the surface. Do not mix different cleaning products. If hair dyes are used, rinse the shower tray with soap and water. Ensure proper ventilation of the space after use.

The grid should be cleaned regularly. Remove it from the drain and use a stainless steel cleaner. Refer to the cleaning product for instructions.

Clean with care to avoid damaging the logo. Soap, shampoo, bath oils or similar products increase the risk of slippage.

LIMESCALE REMOVAL

To periodically remove any remaining traces of limescale, use a domestic anti-lime as follows:

1. Remove the grid from the drain and, with a damp cloth, apply the anti-lime on the entire surface of the shower base.
2. Leave the product for 15 minutes, then rinse with water.
3. Put the grid back in place and rinse again.
